Questions:

- •WHAT do you see in the picture?/Who can explain?
- •WHY do you think it's happening?
- •What do you **KNOW** about this?
- Has it **HAPPENNED** to you or someone in the community?
- •What have you **HEARD** about what you are seeing?

•Remember:

- •Listen to the stories, fears and rumors about the community's experience.
- •Listen **ONLY**. Do **NOT** clarify anything here.



Question:

- •When do you visit the clinic?
- What are some safety measure seen at the clinic?
- Why should we trust the clinic?

• MOH Message:

- Visit the clinic if you are sick or need a check-up.
- Clinic is open now and working.
- We must wash our hands and take temperature at the clinic before entering.
- •The clinic has trained health workers and medicine.

• Rememer:

- Don't talk plenty. Allow the people to talk more.
- Share information by asking questions.



Questions:

- What will you do?
- How are you going to do it?
- •Why will you do that?

• Action:

• Go to the clinic when I am sick or need a check-up.

• Remember:

- Ensure the community makes a decision to take action.
- Ask questions to make people make good decisions.
